

Autumn 1: FS1 Home Learning Challenge

Here are some home learning ideas for you to try over the half term. You can do them all at once, or spread them out over the next six weeks. If you complete all six, you will win a prize!

Find your favourite story, poem, rhyme or song to share and talk about in class, and tell us why it's your favourite. Make sure you have plenty to talk about, practise what you are going to say.

Practise writing your name- it could be the first letter, some of them or maybe your whole first name. You could use a pen, pencil, iPad, chalk... anything!

Learn all the verses to the rhyme. 'The Wheels on the Bus'. Practise the rhyme so you can sing it all by yourself.

Draw a picture of a vehicle you have been in- it could be your family car, train, tram, bus- anything with wheels.

Play a vehicle spotting game next time you go shopping or on a visit. Ask Mr Walters for the tick list.

Build a car or vehicle that can carry a small teddy or figure down a ramp. You will need an adult to help you plan, cut, stick and make it. We will be racing them at the end of term to see whose travels furthest...

In addition, every week you must:

- Practise counting aloud to 5 or 10.
- Count 10 objects (or beyond 10).
- Read a story with a grown-up at least twice a week.
- Draw a picture (and talk about what you have drawn) each week.

You need to be able to tell Mr Walters or one of the FS1 teachers what you have read, drawn or counted.

You will receive a book to read in the week beginning 11/9/17. If you don't get a book pack, please ask a member of staff in FS1.
