

Summer 1 FS1 Home Learning Challenge

Here are some home learning ideas for you to try over the half term. You can do them all at once, or spread them out over the next five weeks. Remember, if you complete all six, you will win a prize! Our topic for Summer 1 is 'Can you build a story?'

Read a traditional story or fairy tale. Learn some of the language e.g. 'Fee fi fo fum' or 'Who is that trip trapping over my bridge?' so you can tell parts of the story to your friends.

Draw a picture or take a photo of things that are:
big, small, huge and tiny.

It's spring! Talk about some of the things you have seen such as plants, animals, natural and found objects. Maybe you could write or draw a list of spring things?

Draw a picture of a fairy tale character- maybe your favourite one. Draw a speech bubble and write something they say in the story e.g. 'This porridge is too hot' or 'I'll huff, and I'll puff and I'll blow your house down.'

Learn to recite a Nursery rhyme. Make sure you know it well, and that you can say it clearly and loud enough for an audience to hear!

Make a prop or something you can use in a fairytale- a magic wand, a witches hat, a fairy, or a model castle. Anything goes!

In addition, every week you must:

- Practise counting aloud to 5 or 10 and beyond.
- Count up to 5 or 10 objects (or beyond 10) and draw the number to match.
- Read a story with a grown-up at least twice a week.
- Draw a picture (and talk about what you have drawn) each week.
- Continue to practise reading and writing your name. Don't forget to begin with a capital letter!

You need to be able to tell Mr Walters or one of the FS1 teachers what you have read, drawn or counted.
