Florence Nightingale was called the Lady with the Lamp because she used her lamp to be able to see when it was dark. Can you make a list of things you have in your house that are sources of light and things that aren't sources of light? What would be useful if we didn't have lights?

Go on a shape hunt around your house and see what you can find that could be halved to make two equal parts. Take some pictures of the things you find to show us. Can you find anything that can't be halved?

Complete your quick maths each week on the sheet attached.

Choose a story book. Once you have read your story book write a book review using the sheet attached.

You should read a book and write a review **every week**.

10 points


Create a 3D model of what a hospital is like now since Florence Nightingale made sure they were clean and safe. You could use:
