Can you think of a creature from under the sea for each letter of the alphabet?</p> <p>5 points</p> <input type="checkbox"/>
<p>Practice your times table, for Times Table Tuesdays. There will be a weekly test on Tuesdays.</p>	<p>Practice your weekly spellings for the test on Fridays. 5 words per week.</p>
