







Autumn 2: Y5 Home Learning Challenge!

Here are some home learning ideas for you to try. You can pick which you do and in which order. They are all worth a different number of points. If you get 50 points by the end of the term you win a prize!

<p>You are an archaeologist who has dug up a box of Anglo Saxon artefacts. What could be inside? Describe in a diary entry, using adjectives and similes that you have found.</p> <p>10 points</p> 	<p>Draw the moon each night and keep a moon diary.</p> <p>10 points</p> 
<p>Can you decipher the code? Then can you write a message in futhark for the class to decode?</p> <p>5 points</p> 	<p>Make an Anglo-Saxon village, house or weapon, such as a sword or shield.</p> <p>15 points</p> 
<p>Use a Dictionary to find these words. The last word in your dictionary Find a homophone word with more than three meanings Open to any page. What's the longest word you see? Find a word you've never heard before, learn the meaning and use the word.</p> <p>10 points</p> 	<p>Design your own (realistic!) Anglo Saxon coin.</p> <p>You can draw it or make it.</p> <p>5 points</p> 
<p>Practice your times table, for Times Table Tuesdays. There will be a weekly test on Tuesdays.</p>	<p>Practice your weekly spellings for the test on Fridays. 10 words per week.</p>
